In his paper, Professor Baker writes that over the past 25 years, Congress has, on average, created over 500 new crimes per decade. His research indicates there are at least 4450 Federal crimes in the U. S. Code, 452 of which being created since 2007. And one of the issues in so many of these new crimes is the mens rea, or the requirement of intent or guilty mind. But one concern is that 6598 would criminalize the possession, transport, or sale of a horse that is intended to be slaughtered that it may allow people...
